## About Susan Wagner, painter

My image anchors are based on landscape, architecture and natural and geometric forms, and through these, I'm able to communicate my interior landscape and express an emotional ambience. I'm attracted to the poetry of movement, singular shapes, bold lines and angles. I use paint, paper, and various media to create something intrinsically human and in my point of view.

I studied Theatre Arts and 20th Century European and Chinese history at the University of Minnesota, Twin Cities. After graduation, I moved to New York to attend NYU film school to get a Master's degree, was accepted into the program, but had to let that go as the need to earn a living was imperative—immediately—and started working in the documentary and feature film industry after a year of terrible jobs. I was lucky to be working in film and I always found time to paint. I'm mostly self-taught—took art classes around the city, including the Art Students League, and could usually be found at the Frick or somewhere else sitting in front of a painting. After many years in the editing profession, I moved to Minneapolis. I started my dedicated painting practice in about 2006.

I didn't realize until much later that the craft of film editing, with its reliance on visual rhythm, story architecture, pacing, and energy had contributed so much to my practice as a painter. I'm grateful for that visual and professional background.
